**a) Do you pour it out for Him, or do you 'ration'?**

**b) How do you measure your devotion when expressing it?**

**(can't separate love and cost)**

### **2) Where's the RISK? -see 2<sup>nd</sup> Samuel 23:13-17**

**Take a pointer from David's mighty men.**

**a) Again, do we sip it or pour it all out at once?**

**b) Do you take risks in worship, making promises?**

**(can't separate love and risk)**

### **3) What's the 'it'? What is worship about?**

**a) Is 'it' the music? Lyrics? Poetry? Art? Dance? Quiet time? The feeling you get?**

**b) Is 'it' worship, or is 'it' Jesus?**

**c) When you build a house, is it just so you can buy nice tools?**

**(The value is NOT in the tools)**

**4) What are you wearing? Look a look at Moses**

**Exodus 34—Moses comes down from the mount**

**with a new 'do'**

**2 Corinthians 3:18—but we, with unveiled faces....**

**Evidence of 'good worship' is that we are changed.**

**What comes between you and Him?**

**1<sup>st</sup> Jn 2:15—don't agape the world or its stuff**
